MACHINE WASHING

- Wash different fibres and colours separately.

- Avoid garments with zippers, hooks, metal parts...

- Make sure items are unfolded when loading the machine.

- Pre-soak delicate fabrics in cold water if required 85 F / 30° C with mild detergent.
- Small, delicate items with lace and embroidery should be enclosed in a large laundry bag.

DRYING / IRONING

- Dry away from direct sunlight.

- Do not dry longer than necessary.
- Luxury fibres (silk, wool, and cashmere) are best professionally cleaned.

- Iron embroidered linens on the reverse side and while damp.

DETERGENT

Avoid powdered detergent or detergents containing alkalis.Be sure the detergent is fully dissolved before adding the fabric.



STORING

- Store linens folded flat in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area.
 - Avoid storing linens in plastic bags and boxes, as natural fibres need to breathe.
 - Make sure stored linens are not exposed to direct sunlight to avoid permanent yellowing.
